<b>Verb (action)</b>	<b>Definition from Oxford English dictionary</b>
Acknowledge	To accept that something has a particular status
Acquire	Obtain (an asset or object) for oneself
Allocate	Distribute (resources or duties) for a particular purpose
Archive	Transfer (data) to a less frequently used storage medium such as magnetic tape
Assess	Calculate or estimate the value of
Associate	Connect (something) with something else because they occur together or one produces the other
Attach	Add or fasten (a related document) to another, or to an email
Broadcast	Transmit (a programme or some information) without an address
Buffer	Store (data) in a buffer while it is being processed or transferred
Capture	Cause (data) to be stored in a computer
Check	Verify the accuracy of something by comparing it with (something else)
Classify	Arrange (a group of people or things) in classes or categories according to shared qualities or characteristics
Compare	Estimate, measure, or note the similarity or dissimilarity between
Compute	Reckon or calculate (a figure or amount)
Control	Determine the behavior or supervise the running of
Convert	Be able to change from one form to another.
Coordinate	Bring the different elements of (a complex activity or organization) into a harmonious or efficient relationship
Correct	Adjust (a numerical result or reading) to allow for departure from standard conditions
Correlate	Show that there is a close connection between two or more facts, figures, etc.
Create	Bring (something) into existence
Deduplicate	Eliminate duplicate or redundant information from (something, especially computer data)
Delete	Remove something that has been stored on a computer
Deploy	Use something effectively
Detect	Discover or identify the presence or existence of
Dispatch	Send a message somewhere
Display	Show (data or an image) on a computer, television, or other screen
Duplicate	Make or be an exact copy of
Enable	Give (someone) the authority or means to do something; make it possible for
Execute	To do a piece of work, perform a duty, put a plan into action...
Export	Transfer (data) in a format that can be used by other programs
Expose	Let somebody find out about something by giving them experience of it or showing them what it is like
Extract	Obtain (a substance or resource) from something by a special method
Filter	Process or assess (items) in order to reject those that are unwanted
Forward	Send or pass information to somebody
Generate	Produce or create
Grant	Give (a right, power, property, etc.) formally or legally to
Host	Store (a website or other data) on a server or other computer so that it can be accessed over the Internet
Identify	Establish or indicate who or what (someone or something) is
Import	Get data from another program, changing its form so that the program can read it

Verb (action)	Definition from Oxford English dictionary
Infer	Deduce or conclude (something) from evidence and reasoning rather than from explicit statements
Initiate	Cause (a process or action) to begin
Lock	Restrict access to the full functionality or data of (a computer, mobile phone, file, etc.), especially by requiring a user to verify their identity with a passcode or other form of authentication.
Log	Make a systematic recording of events, observations, or measurements.
Maintain	Cause or enable (a condition or situation) to continue.
Manage	Keep something under control; to be able to deal with something
Mark	(of a particular quality or feature) distinguish (someone or something) from other people or things.
Merge	Combine or cause to combine to form a single entity.
Monitor	Observe and check the progress or quality of (something) over a period of time; keep under systematic review.
Perform	Carry out, accomplish, or fulfil (an action, task, or function)
Pre-correlate	To show that there is a close connection between two or more facts, figures, etc.
Print	Produce (text or a picture) by a printing process
Process	Operate on (data) by means of a program
Publish	Make (content) available online
Receive	Detect or pick up (broadcast signals)
Record	Convert (sound or a performance) into a permanent form for subsequent reproduction or broadcast
Register	Enter or record on an official list or directory
Repeat	Do or produce something again or more than once
Replay	Play again something that has been recorded
Request	Ask for something or ask somebody to do something
Retrieve	Find or extract (information stored in a computer)
Route	Send or direct along a specified course
Search	Look for information in (a database or the World Wide Web) using a search engine
Select	Carefully choose as being the best or most suitable
Send	Cause (a message or computer file) to be transmitted electronically
Set	To cause something to be in a particular state
Simulate	Produce a computer model of
Split	Divide, or to make something divide, into two or more parts
Store	Retain or enter (information) for future electronic retrieval
Support	Allow the use or operation of (a program, language, or device)
Synchronise	Cause (a set of data or files) to remain identical in more than one location
Test	Use or try to find out how well it works or to find out more information about it
Transmit	Broadcast or send out (an electrical signal or a radio or television programme)
Trigger	Cause (an event or situation) to happen or exist
Update	Give (someone) the latest information about something
Validate	Prove that something is true
Verify	Check that something is true or accurate
